

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY FOR POULTRY & EQUIPMENT

1. The sale will consist of the following sections: Poultry (PO), Bantams (BA), Waterfowl (WA), Domestic Geese (DG), Wild Geese (WG), Wildfowl (WI), Ornamental Pheasant (PH), Guinea Fowl (GF), Pea Fowl (PF), Turkeys (T), Quail (Q), Pigeons and Doves (PI), Sitting Eggs (SE) and Deadstock (DS). Please indicate section on entry form.
2. Lots will be catalogued alphabetically. Please list entries alphabetically by section on entry form. Order of Sale to rotate at each sale.
3. Quantity of birds in each lot:
PR - 1 hen and 1 cockerel
TRIO - 2 hens and 1 cockerel
Quartet - 3 hens and 1 cockerel
Quintet - 4 hens and 1 cockerel
A maximum of three birds per lot of fully grown Large Fowl. Otherwise a maximum of five birds per lot except for hen with chicks and pigeons (NB 24" pens). Cages containing only male birds will **NOT** be accepted within the poultry or bantam sections. This decision has been made due to lack of demand for cock birds. Entries of male birds in other section, ie domestic geese and waterfowl, will continue to be accepted.
4. Sex: M = Male F = Female
5. Please state year of hatch.
6. Comments.
P - Pinioned to prevent sustained flight
URS - Unrelated stock
ES - Exhibition/show strain stock
FR - Free range stock
POL - Point of lay
L - Laying
C - Clipped
W - Wormed
BP - Breeding pair
V - Vaccinated
7. Reserves. All lots will be offered on a per cage basis.
8. All stock must be **pure bred**, of good quality and be true to type (Only crossbred Silkie and Sussex for broodies will be accepted). They must be healthy and in clean condition. Any entry which does not comply with these requirements will be rejected and the entry fee will not be refunded. Those birds will be removed to quarantine cages.
9. No straw to be used in the cages.
10. All poultry and wildfowl must be off heat. Any chicks offered not off heat, must be sold with their hen.
11. Any alteration from the catalogued entry must be clearly displayed on the cage and written notice of the alteration be given to the Auctioneer's staff before commencement of the sale. Please avoid substitutions if at all possible.
12. No advertising will be allowed on cages.
13. Vendors are responsible for the safety and wellbeing of their birds, including the provision of drinking vessels, food and shavings up until the fall of the hammer.
14. All equipment offered will be sold as seen. Any electrical item must be tested as safe or otherwise it will be sold as scrap.
15. **Entry fee £2.50** (inclusive of VAT) will be charged per cage or item of deadstock. **Late entries will be charged £4** (inclusive of VAT). An **Entry fee of 50p** (inclusive of VAT) will be charged on sitting eggs. **Late entries will be charged £1** (inclusive of VAT). An **Entry fee of £1** (inclusive of VAT) will be charged on boxes of young chicks. **Late entries will be charged £2** (inclusive of VAT). A cheque made payable to **Greenslade Taylor Hunt** to accompany the entry form.
16. In the event of the sale being cancelled once advertising has been incurred, due to Bird Flu or any other circumstance beyond the control of the Auctioneers, the Auctioneers will refund entry fees in proportion to the amount of advertising undertaken.
17. Commission will be charged on all lots at 10%. A minimum commission of £1 (exclusive of VAT) will be charged on each lot, excluding sitting eggs.
18. All exhibits will be judged by the Taunton Poultry Fanciers Club. 15 classes. Prize Money of £15 and £10 to Champion and Reserve pens. All lots to be caged by **11am** for judging.
