### **SUMMERISED CONDITIONS OF SALE**

VENDORS PLEASE NOTE: Should the sale of any animal be annulled due to misdescription, full commission on the lost sale will be due from the vendor. No substitutions to the main catalogue will be accepted. The Auctioneer's reserve the right to levy a £100 fine on vendors who fail to present for sale their entries unless a veterinary certificate can be provided.

### **NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED ON THE DAY OF SALE**

**RESERVE PRICES:** Reserves maybe placed on the entry form submitted for cataloguing. Should any Vendor wish to change their reserve thereafter or establish a reserve on the Sale Day Vendors are to obtain a Sale Day Reserve Form and hand it with the revised or new reserve price written upon to the Auctioneers in the rostrum at the time of sale of each lot.

Unless a reserve price is given to the Auctioneers in writing before a lot is offered, the lot will be sold without reserve to the highest bidder. Where a lot fails to make its reserve and is subsequently sold privately on the day of sale, such private sale must be booked through the Auctioneers, upon which full commission will be charged. Failure to observe this rule will result in defaulters being barred from future sales.

### **THE WELFARE OF HORSES AT MARKETS ORDER (1990)**

Vendors are advised that by law the following must not be submitted for sale:

1. UNFIT HORSES i.e. ones which are diseased, ill, injured, lame, deformed emaciated, weak or exhausted etc.
2. A mare during the last month of pregnancy.
3. Foals less than 18 weeks of age -unless at the foot of the dam.

NOTE: Any foal sold away from its dam must be fully weaned before the sale.

### **ADDITIONAL WELFARE CRITERIA**

1. 2 year old fillies which have been running with a stallion are not accepted into the sale.
2. No ponies over 20 years of age will be accepted into the sale.
3. Only ponies of four years old or over may be clipped.
4. Ponies between 18 and 20 years of age must have a vet's certificate stating that the pony is fit to travel.
5. No ponies will be accepted for sale if they have undergone any form of surgical procedure within 4 weeks of the sale date.
6. Foals, unless being sold at foot, must be weaned. This means they must be able to drink water and eat hard feed independently.
7. Lactating mares are not accepted unless sold with a foal at foot.

### **LAME & UNFIT ANIMALS**

1. Lots must be free of contagious disease and of any substance capable of affecting performance or soundness.
2. The sale of ANY horse which is lame or unfit may be annulled and the purchase money refunded in full provided that the purchaser reports the lameness or unfitness to the Auctioneers not later than 12 Noon on the second day following the close of sale and the complaint verified by a qualified veterinary surgeon.

### **GENERAL:**

1. All lots are sold without warranty and may only be returned to the vendor if, by law, its condition prohibits its sale (see unfit horses above.)
2. All lots are to be halter broken and led through sale ring by vendor. All sold lots must be left with a head collar.
3. A bale of straw will be provided for each pen. Hay will be available for purchase.
4. All ponies, including foals, must have a passport and must have been registered with the SPSBS by 15th July 2009.
5. All lots born on or after 1st July 2009 must be micro chipped.
